

**"Hữu Nghị: Singapore & Vietnam 50-10 Exhibition"  
EXTENDED at the Pan Pacific Hanoi**



HANOI – Due to popular demand, the ***Hữu Nghị: Singapore & Vietnam Celebrates 50-10 Exhibition*** has been extended! From 26<sup>th</sup> September to 10<sup>th</sup> October 2023, it will make its second run at the Pan Pacific Hanoi, in celebration of the 5-star hotel's 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

The exhibition's recent run at the prestigious Vietnam Fine Arts Museum, in early September, had received much traction and media coverage, garnering one of the highest attendance at the museum. Officially launched by H.E. Mr Jaya Ratnam, Ambassador of the Republic of Singapore to Vietnam, it was supported by the Singapore Embassy in Hanoi, Singapore Global Network, and more than 20 kind sponsors, including Singapore Airlines, The Hanoi Club Hotel & Residences, BIDV Tower Joint Venture Company, Brand Craft Studios, World Trippin Media, Savills Hanoi, and Pan Pacific Hanoi.

Its art sharing session with a curatorial walkthrough was one of the first to be conducted at the museum, and a refreshing delight to many who had attended.

Themed "Hữu Nghị", which means "friendship" in Vietnamese, it is more than just a showcase of art. It is a testament to the enduring bonds and spirit of cooperation that have united these two nations. With the theme of friendship and cooperation at its core, the exhibition delves into the shared cultural heritage, values, and aspirations that bind Singapore and Vietnam together. Both Vietnamese and Singaporean artists explore their unique interpretations of people, culture, lifestyles, and the built environment. Through an array of captivating artworks, the exhibition
